



No. of Active Users by Country (2024)







Enhancing the climate and disaster resilience of the most vulnerable rural and emerging urban human settlements in Lao PDR

UN-Habitat has worked on enhancing the climate and disaster resilience of the most vulnerable human settlements in three southern provinces of Lao PDR. Small-scale water supply systems have been established to provide clean water resources for residents in villages and to support sanitation facilities.

As part of the project, UN-Habitat organized a functionality check to evaluate whether the built or improved small-scale water supply systems are still functioning properly or if there are any challenges or difficulties since being handed over to the villages for use.



Before, having a toilet was a challenge as it was too difficult to carry water from the river. Now that we can access water easily, every household has a toilet.

Many families have started to build toilets since the connection of water to their house. We aim to achieve 100% of household have at least a toilet within 2024.


